Fall River Cruise Southern Style

Hampton, Newport News, Virginia Beach, Portsmouth and Norfolk

Travel to Tidewater Virginia for a beautifully relaxing tour. Your tour begins with a stop at the lovely **Norfolk Botanical Gardens**. There are 155 beautiful acres intertwined by bridges and coastal waterways. You are surrounded by beauty year-round by roses, azaleas, camellias and hollies.
